- b) All researcher reimbursable (supplies) costs will attract a 10% support fee.
- c) Fuel will be issued at the recommended pump price in Nanyuki.
- d) Researchers whose cumulative accommodation aggregates a month will receive a 15% discount.
- e) Researchers who may need exclusive access to a house will be required to liaise with finance department for rate concurrence.
- f) Daily research support includes access to Mpala, non-specialized labs, use of internet, lunch and teas. This does not include transport to and from Mpala. Any additional expenses will be handled as provided under (b) above.
