#### Fees in USD

Mpala is dedicated to expanding the research community and promoting inclusivity by providing discounted accommodation rates and granting access to facilities and services. Our focus is on encouraging research collaborations with groups that have been historically underrepresented. To support this goal, we have maintained affordable accommodation rates for East African students and researchers. Furthermore, we have established an annual fund to assist Kenyan students and researchers in their research endeavors at Mpala.

**NOTES:**

- a) Accommodation is provided on single occupancy. Double occupancy (extra person) will be billed at 75% of the applicable rate.
- b) All researcher reimbursable (supplies) cost will attract a 10% support fee.
- c) Fuel will be issued at the recommended pump price in Nanyuki.
- d) Researchers whose cumulative accommodation aggregates a month will receive 15% discount.
- e) Researcher who may need exclusive access to a house will be required to liaise with finance department for rate concurrence.
- f) Daily research support includes access to Mpala, non-specialized labs, use of Internet, lunch and teas. This does not include transport to and from Mpala. Any additional expenses will be handled as provided under (b) above.
